450 1066 Romans left Great Britain Battle of Hastings: end of Anglo-Saxon period



Roman Conquest of Britain: 55 BC – 450 AD

BC = **Before Christ**

AD = Anno Domini = After the year Christ was born

Anno Domini is Latin for "the Year of the Lord", referring to the year that Jesus Christ was born.

End of the Roman occupation? Mayhem!

450 AD: Romans left Britain

- Britain attacked by Celts
- and German tribes (Angles, Saxons, Jutes)
- > Old-English

= Migration Period



Settlers established kingdoms

Frequent wars between kings

Anglo-Saxon kings surrounded themselves with young warriors, who were rewarded for their loyalty.

7th century Many Anglo-Saxons were converted to Christianity Written language – Latin and Old English

- Historia Ecclesiastica Gentis Anglorum
 - The Ecclasiastical History of the English People
 - Written by a monk, Bede (672 735), in Latin
 - In 731 AD
 - On politics, history and religion
- Beowulf
 - Epic poem written in Old English
 - Author unknown
 - Probably 6th century
