

Oefening 4 relative clauses met 'who(m)', 'which', 'that', [niets]

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Voeg de volgende zinnen samen zoals in het voorbeeld. Vul alle mogelijkheden in en onderstreep de keuze(s) die de voorkeur heeft (hebben).

Voorbeeld:

She climbed to the top of the church tower to see the panorama. She had been told about this panorama.

She climbed to the top of the church tower to see the panorama which/that/ - she had been told about.
[‘ - ‘ = ‘niets’]

relative clauses, relative pronouns

Oefening 5 relative clauses met ‘who(m)’, ‘which’, ‘that’, [niets]

Vertaal de volgende zinnen. Soms kun je alleen ‘who(m)’ of ‘which’ gebruiken. Soms is ook ‘that’ mogelijk. In sommige zinnen is het **relative pronoun** niet het onderwerp van de bijzin (the **relative clause**). Dan kun je het relative pronoun ook weglaten. Lees eerst 6.1.2 nog eens door en kies dan steeds voor een mogelijkheid die de voorkeur heeft in het Engels. In sommige bijzinnen kom je voorzetsels tegen; lees daarvoor eerst 6.1.7 nog even door.

Oefening 6 relative clauses - alle soorten

Voeg de volgende zinnen samen door **relative clauses** te gebruiken. Let op: alle onderdelen van hoofdstuk 6 kunnen aan bod komen. We geven drie voorbeelden

Voorbeelden:

The train crashed into a field of cows. Six of them were killed.

The train crashed into a field of cows, six of which were killed. (lees 6.1.8 nog maar eens door)

Jack's tyres did not have snow chains. He wanted to stick to the busier roads.

Jack, whose tyres didn't have snow chains, wanted to stick to the busier roads. (6.1.4)

The cats howled all night. This kept us awake.

The cats howled all night, which kept us awake. [of:]

The cats which/that howled all night, kept us awake.

- 1 We sat in the same room as a man with a mobile phone. His phone went off every five minutes.

- 2 She spoke in Dutch. But the students didn't know Dutch. She was speaking to these students. (Combineer de laatste twee zinnen: The students)

- 3 Simon's arm is still in plaster. He will have to watch the match from the bench.

- 4 The football match was so noisy that I couldn't hear the person at the other end of the line. I was phoning from this football match.

- 5 He introduced me to his family. Most of them were from Scotland.
-

- 6 He wanted me to pay 3 pounds for a jigsaw. Some of the pieces were missing.

- 7 The victims were given rooms in the hostel. Their homes had been destroyed in the fire.

- 8 He paid me £10 for cleaning six cars. Most of them hadn't been cleaned for months.

- 9 This is Mr Jackson. His wife won the competition last year.

- 10 She refuses to answer the phone. This makes her life more lonely.

- 11 We went to the Bahamas. We had always wanted to go to the Bahamas on holiday.

- 12 The manager said she was too busy to see me. I had come specially to see her.
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
